FEMA Registration Deadline Extended to May 1

Do you have storm-related damage and need assistance?

Even if you don't qualify for assistance from FEMA, you must register and receive a FEMA number to be eligible to apply for a SBA (Small Business Association) Loan.

Why should I register with the SBA?

SBA Loans are for anyone with storm related damage. **You do not have to own a business to qualify for a SBA loan, but you must first register with FEMA. There are also many grants available and in order to qualify you MUST be registered with the SBA .**

How to Apply to FEMA

Anyone with storm losses in all counties in New Jersey can register online at DisasterAssistance.gov, via smartphone or tablet at m.fema.gov or call 1.800-621-3362, TTY 800-462-7585 or 711/VRS. The toll-free telephone numbers operate from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. seven days a week.

FEMA disaster assistance for individuals and families can include money for rental assistance, essential home repairs, personal property and other serious disaster-related needs not covered by insurance.

How to Apply to for a SBA Loan

The simplest way to complete a SBA application is online by using the electronic loan application. Go to DisasterLoan.SBA.gov/ELA. More information is available by calling the SBA customer service center at 800-659-2955 or TTY 800-877-8339. SBA disaster loans are the largest source of federal recovery funds for individuals with property or content losses.

You must register with FEMA & then you will be eligible to apply for a SBA Loan or others grants.

World Renew Comes to Monmouth County April 25, 2013

What is World Renew?

World Renew Disaster Response Services (DRS), based out of Grand Rapids, Michigan, has responded to disasters in the United States for more than 40 years, and has been active in New York and New Jersey responding to Hurricane Sandy devastation since the disaster occurred.

What will World Renew do in Monmouth County?

20 trained volunteers from World Renew will conduct community assessments of unmet needs in Monmouth County beginning April 25. They will contact families that have registered with FEMA for help. For those still with unmet needs, World Renew will conduct in-depth interviews at walk-in centers in Manasquan and Belmar. **(See locations and hours below.)**

Assessments will be prioritized and turned over to the Monmouth County Long-Term Recovery Group (www.mcltrg.org) and the Manasquan Organization of Volunteer Efforts (MOVE) for follow-up.

How long will World Renew be in Monmouth County?

The Unmet Needs Assessment Team will be here from April 25 through May 7.
