

Notice to Bidders

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, Monmouth County, New Jersey for the **MANASQUAN WATER TREATMENT PLANT MODIFICATIONS – LIME SLURRY CHEMICAL FEED SYSTEM** and opened and read in public at the Manasquan Borough Hall, 201 East Main Street, Manasquan, New Jersey, on **November 22, 2016 at 10:00 A.M.** prevailing time.

This project will involve the removal of an existing slaked lime chemical feed system and installation of a new lime slurry chemical feed system. The scope of work will include the building modifications to include pavement, masonry, electrical, piping, HVAC and controls work necessary to install the proposed chemical feed system.

Contract Documents and drawings for the proposed work, prepared by the Borough Engineer, James Priolo, P.E, of the firm of Maser Consulting P.A., 331 Newman Springs Road, Suite 203, Red Bank, New Jersey, are on file in the Office of Engineer and may be inspected by prospective bidders during business hours.

Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Contract Documents by request upon proper notice and payment of a non-refundable charge of Seventy Five dollars (\$75.00) payable to Maser Consulting P.A. to defray the cost thereof.

Proposals must be made on the Standard Proposal Forms in the manner designated in the contract documents, must be enclosed in sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder, and the name of the work on the outside, addressed to Municipal Clerk, Borough of Manasquan; and must be accompanied by all items identified in the Contract Documents including, but not limited to, a statement of Consent of Surety from a surety company holding a Certificate of Authorization to do business in the State of New Jersey and bid guarantee (Proposal Security) for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid except that the guarantee need not exceed \$20,000.00.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17.27.

Bidders are also required to comply with other provisions of Law including, but not limited to, the requirements of:

- N.J.S.A. 52.25-24.2 (P.L., c.33, Disclosure of Ownership)
- N.J.S.A. 52:32-44 (P.L. 2004, c.57, Business Registration)
- N.J.S.A. 34.11-56.25, et seq. (P.L. 1963, c.150 Prevailing Wages)
