

To: Residents of First Ave. (sections), Brielle Road (part), and Stockton Ave. (between First and Second Ave.)

Dear Resident,

As you know the Borough Council has approved an ADA project at certain intersections along First Avenue. In addition, some street paving will be done on the streets impacted by this work. You can see the areas impacted on the project map which is attached. We are not doing the entire length of First Avenue at this time.

The scope of work involves ADA ramps on all corners shown, new storm drains at certain locations, overlay of the intersection and new street markings. In addition, on Brielle Road from the easterly end to where the Brielle Road project ended just west of First Avenue, the street will be paved. We are also doing some curb and sidewalk work and paving on Stockton Avenue, between First and Second Avenues.

The project is currently scheduled to start next week and the contractor should be sending an additional notice to the affected homeowners.

As mentioned in the letter dated September 15, 2016, we recommend that if you plan to do any water line or sewer line work to your home, you do this before the final paving is completed. The Borough road opening ordinance calls for an eight (8) year moratorium on opening roadways following a paving project. The ordinance does provide for exceptions to this eight (8) year moratorium, but requires a more costly opening repair.
