

As a part of its Safety Acceleration and Facility Enhancement (SAFE) program approved by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities in 2012, New Jersey Natural Gas (NJNG) is replacing certain portions of its existing infrastructure that is aged and most susceptible to corrosion and leaks.

On or about May 16, 2016, NJNG will be replacing sections of bare and unprotected steel distribution main and associated services east of Route 71 in Manasquan, NJ. The following roads will be affected:

- **East Main St** from Pershing to Lockwood
- **Rogers Ave** from Meadow to North Potter
- **Lockwood Ave** from East Main to Rogers
- **North Potter Ave** from Rogers to Ocean
- **Fletcher Ave** from North Potter to Wyckoff
- **McLean Ave** from North Potter to Minerva
- **Lake Ave** from North Potter to N. McClellan
- **North Jackson** from Lake to Stockton Lake
- **Cowart Ave** from Lake to Minerva
- **Minerva Ave** from Fletcher to Stockton Lake
- **Watson Ave** from East Main to Euclid
- **North Farragut** from Fletcher to East Main
- **Euclid Ave** from South Farragut to Route 71

Work is expected to last approximately seven months. During construction, please be mindful of potential traffic impacts, including lane shifts, closures and detours.

NJNG's contractor will replace and/or reconnect all natural gas service lines in the project area at no cost to the property owner. Affected property owners will be contacted to make arrangements for their natural gas service to be restored at a mutually agreeable time. Additionally, in order to relight all appliances NJNG will require access to the property.
