


## **SUPPORT GROUP HELP FOR GRIEVING CHILDREN**

Rainbows trained facilitators use proven age-appropriate curriculum for children support groups which have helped over 3 million of our youth for over 32 years.

**Rainbows helps children** providing a safe environment to express their feelings and realize they are not alone. The program helps children develop problem solving and appropriate behavior management skills.

**Rainbows participants are children grades K-8 ages 5-14** and adults with children in Rainbows.

**Rainbows is free of charge and open to all families in Monmouth County** from all economic, racial, ethnic, and religious backgrounds, and from two-parent, single- parent, or foster-parent families.

**When is Rainbows?** Our first meeting and orientation is Monday October 12<sup>th</sup>, 2015 from 6p to 745pm. Thereafter we will meet on Monday nights this fall from 645pm to 745pm.
