



The Manasquan Police Department is looking to reduce the speed limit on six streets within the municipality. (Manasquan cannot reduce the speed limits on county and state roadways) The plan would be to reduce the speed limit from 30 MPH to 25 MPH on the following streets:

- 1.) The length of North Main Street
- 2.) Main Street from 100 feet west of the center of South Street to North Main Street
- 3.) The length of Brielle Road
- 4.) East Main Street from Wyckoff Avenue east to First Avenue
- 5.) Stockton Lake Boulevard from Highway 71 to North McClellan Avenue
- 6.) The length of Third Avenue.
